Document	Rollback checklist (12 checks)
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CHECKS

Checks

Tick only with evidence attached.

- ☐ **Rollback triggers defined**
Objective triggers written before cutover: validation failure, lag breach, smoke-test failure, elapsed time.
- ☐ **Decision authority named**
One person can call rollback; no committee during the window.
- ☐ **Re-point procedure**
Service-name/DNS flip back documented step by step.
- ☐ **Writes during target-live**
Any writes accepted on PostgreSQL have a re-sync plan back to Oracle.
- ☐ **Sequence divergence handled**
Sequence values advanced on PostgreSQL are reconciled before re-pointing.
- ☐ **Rehearsed in non-prod**
Rollback executed at least once in rehearsal; timings recorded.
- ☐ **Application rollback paired**
Application deployment rollback paired with database rollback where coupled.
- ☐ **Comms plan drafted**
Rollback communication drafted in advance.
- ☐ **Post-rollback validation**
Source health, counts, and smoke tests re-run after rollback.
- ☐ **Root cause before retry**
Cutover not re-attempted until the failure's root cause is fixed.
- ☐ **Rollback window expiry**
Explicit point after which forward-fix only; no rollback offered.
- ☐ **Sign-off logged**
Decision, timestamps, and decision maker recorded.
